

## November 8, 2022 Statewide General Election

### Important dates for jurisdictions calling elections

<b>May/June 2022</b>	<p>Suggested time for jurisdictions holding elections in November to pass a resolution that 1) orders the election; 2) requests the Santa Cruz County Elections Department to conduct the election, and 3) consolidates it with any other jurisdiction holding an election on that same day.</p> <p>The following documents can be found on our website at <a href="http://www.votescount.us">www.votescount.us</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Sample Resolution for School Districts</li> <li>• Sample Resolution for Cities/Special District</li> </ul>
<b>July 18, 2022</b>	Candidate filing begins. Click here for a list of offices on the ballot.
<b>August 12, 2022</b>	Last day to call an election or file for office. If the incumbent does not file, filing is extended for 5 calendar days for anyone other than the incumbent.
<b>August 12, 2022</b>	Deadline for filing tax rate statement for bond measures. Last day to file Tax Rate Statement for any bond measure appearing on the November ballot.
<b>August 19, 2022</b>	<p>Deadline for filing arguments for or against local ballot measures.</p> <p>Deadline for filing analyses of local ballot measures.</p>
<b>August 26, 2022</b>	Deadline for filing rebuttals.
<b>September 9, 2022</b>	First day to mail ballots to military and overseas voters
<b>October 10, 2022</b>	First day to mail ballots to vote-by-mail voters.
<b>October 24, 2022</b>	Last day to register to vote in November 2022 election.
<b>November 5 &amp; 6, 2022</b>	Weekend voting – open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. at Santa Cruz County Elections and Watsonville City Hall.
<b>November 8, 2022</b>	Election Day – polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m.
<b>November 15, 2022</b>	E+7 – VBM ballots postmarked on or before Election Day and received by November 15 will be counted.
<b>December 4, 2022</b>	E+26 – last day to cure an unsigned signature on VBM envelope.
