

I'm an environmental leader and music teacher who loves to serve the Pajaro Valley as a PVUSD Board Trustee. As a climate refugee from Fresno, I'm honored to reside where my grandfather was a bracero farmworker. I've helped win big campaigns to ban fracking and protect farmland in our County. As a violinist and teacher, I enjoy coaching youth mariachi and orchestra.

When I ran for this seat in 2020, over 2400 people voted for me. Last year I was unanimously appointed by the PVUSD Board after Maria Orozco went to the Watsonville City Council. In the past year we've made progress!

We delivered a 15 percent raise for our teachers, making our salaries and benefits competitive with nearby districts. We made our music programs stronger and stopped cuts to visual arts. We hired a new Superintendent and our staff is working better together.
